

1. COOKIES POLICY

1.1 Cookies are small text files with information, stored on your computer when you visit a website via a computer, phone, or other connected device. There are essentially two types of cookies. So-called session cookies are stored temporarily and disappear when the user closes the web browser. Session cookies may, for instance, determine which language the user has chosen. The second type, permanent cookies, are saved for a longer period of time on the user's device and has a specific expiration date. When this date expires, the cookie is deleted when the user returns to the site that created the cookie. This type of cookie may, for instance, be used to tell users if something has changed on the website since the last visit or for the site to "remember" if the user has previously decided to hide the pop-up about the use of cookies.

2. LAWS AND REGULATIONS

2.1 The Electronic Communications Act (2003:389) governs the use of cookies. The General Data Protection Regulation ((EU) 2016:679) may in some cases apply if the cookies generate personally identifiable information, which is not the case at wordfinder.com.

3. COOKIES AT WORDFINDER.COM

- 3.1 WordFinder uses cookies at wordfinder.com to optimize your experience and the functionality of our website, without collecting any personally identifiable data. The cookies are necessary i.a. in order for you to take advantage of WordFinder's online store and web application, for the browser to remember your identification when you log in, and for you to use your WordFinder product and/or services and your subscription with the right functionality. The cookies used do not allow WordFinder to gather any personal information about you.
- 3.2 The table below shows which cookies are used at wordfinder.com.
- 3.3 Most web browsers allow you to apply settings controlling if cookies are to be saved or rejected and usually allow cookies as default. You can customize the settings to alert you as soon as a cookie is sent to your computer or to block cookies completely. You can also choose to delete the currently stored cookies. The web browser's help function usually provides guidance on how to customize the settings. If you choose to block the cookies from wordfinder.com, some features may not be fully functional.
